

**DR. J. C. CAMPBELL DEAD.**  
He Passes Peacefully Away at the Ripe Age  
of Eighty-nine Years.

Dr. J. C. Campbell, a former citizen of Wheeling, for years among the leading members of the Ohio county bar, died yesterday at his home on the Bethany Pike, this county, aged nearly eighty-nine years. Dr. Campbell will be well remembered by older citizens, though he has for years lived in the country. When the late J. H. Pendleton came to Wheeling he entered into partnership with Dr. Campbell, who had already established a large and lucrative practice. The deceased left three children, one being the wife of Dr. W. J. Bates, another the widow of the late Major Richard Savage, and the third, John C. Campbell, an officer in the U. S. Navy. He was a brilliant and successful member of his profession, and since his retirement has lived quietly at his home in the country, retaining the respect of his old acquaintances in an eminent degree. His family have the sympathy of an unusually wide circle of acquaintances and friends in their bereavement.
