For the second time within a week, a truck driver saved his life by leaping from a truck as his vehicle went out of control while traveling down a mountain road.

Lloyd E. Ferguson was slightly injured last Thursday when he jumped from his truck as it approached a big curve on the Pleasantville Mountain. The damage was listed at \$3,000.

On Tuesday of last week, Harry L. Gibson of Easton, Md., jumped from his run-away truck as it was descending Allegheny Mountain near Schellsburg.

Ferguson said that his brakes failed and the truck jumped out of gear. As it gained momentum, he jumped to save his life.

Ferguson's truck, like Gibson's, was loaded with steel.
