Here's a copy of Broeke's Social Security application showing her dad as William. I don't know if he was William George or George William.

The other paper is the 1880 Census from SURVATA Township in Bedford county. It lists William, Mary, Jessie and Phoebe. There were two other sisters and at least one brother. I have their names and who they married somewhere.

Notice that Mary (or William) didn't know where her father was born. Did she know her dad? William would have been born in 1846

Mary in 1858, probably both in Juniata Township. Have been going over the papers you sent. Don't know any of them. Wasn't Uncle Bill's friend that owned the flower shop there in Bedford a Fisher? I can't remember his name.

William and Mary were probably married in 1878. Not sure if they had such a thing back then but the application for marriage license would list both William and Mary parents.

Okay, I went and dug them up. George (or ?) was living in Cumberland when Broeke died. The sisters aren't listed in the obit but Jessie married a Hoover, Cora married a Wernaker and Nettie married a Winegardner.

Don't know when they married or if they had kids or where they lived.

Hope some of this helps. I think that Bedford has a genealogical place. Probably by the courthouse or library. Let me know if you need some \$ for the information you get.

Notice on the 1870 census, the name is spelled with an "o" instead of an "r". Also shows no children and Mary is born in Pa. Then on the 1880 census, they have a daughter "Delra" (which I think is Debra) that is 12 and should have been on the 1870 census.

It also shows Mary being born in England but I can't find where she came to the U.S. Mom said her name was Bousbern but back then it could be spelled Bousbern. I'll find her yet.

Now for some catching up.
