

Louisa Pape "Will".
The Last Will And Testament

Of

Louise Pape

I, Louise Pape, of Waddle's Run, Ohio County, West Virginia, do make this my last will and testament, hereby revoking any and all former wills by me heretofore made.

First: I direct that my executor hereinafter appointed shall pay all of my just debts and funeral expenses.

Second: I hereby direct my executor hereinafter named to pay to my dearly beloved grandchildren, Edna, Louisa and Louis Hartlieb, Jr., the sum of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) each.

Third: I further direct that my executor hereinafter named shall pay to my son, Fred Pape, of Cohasset, Massachusetts, the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

Fourth: I hereby devise and bequeath the surface of my farm on the waters of Short Creek, in Ohio County, West Virginia, to my son, Charlie Pape, for and during his natural life and upon his death I will and bequeath that the land shall pass to my grandchildren then living, share and share alike, to be theirs forever. The coal underlying said land I hereby devise and bequeath to my grandchildren living at the time of the death of the said Charlie Pape to be divided among said grandchildren, share and share alike.

Fifth: All the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, real, personal, and mixed, wheresoever situate, of which I may die seized and possessed, or to which I may be entitled at the time of my decease, I give, devise and bequeath to my three children, Charlie Pape, Lena R. Green and Wilhelmina Sager, share and share alike.

Sixth: I hereby appoint the National Bank of West Virginia the executor of this, my last will and testament.
