At the conclusion of the ceremony the glad notes of the "Tannhaenser" march filled the edifice, and keeping step to them, the bridal party made its way down through rows of smiling faces to the parlors of the church, where an impromptu reception was held till 4 o'clock, when Mr. and Mrs. Singleton were driven to the Pan Handle depot where they took a train for the East, where they will remain for two weeks or more.
