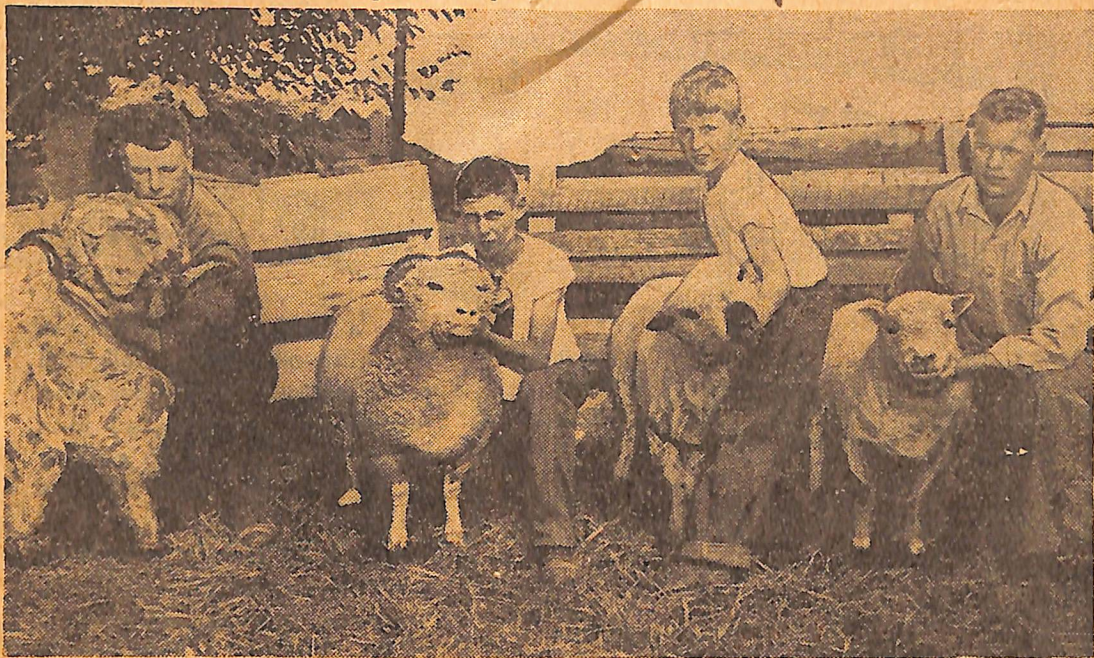


Some of Many Sheep Shown At Jacktown Fair
