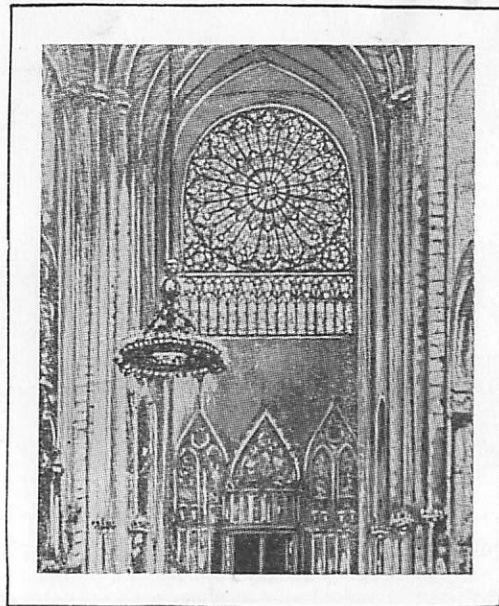


*Fast as the rolling
